

Thirteen Lynnville-Sully student athletes capped their track seasons with 10 events at the 2015 Iowa High School State Track and Field Championships May 21-23 at Drake Fieldhouse in Des Moines. Four of these athletes, seniors Shelby Davis, Madison Rasmusson, Cori Rice, and Noah Zylstra, made the final trips of their high school track career around the blue oval, culminating a track career that included multiple state appearances, personal bests, and broken school records.

The girls track team's history-making season saw them become the first girls state-qualifying track meet team championship in school history. The girls qualified seven events for Class 1-A state track competition where they tied for 20th place.

On the boys' side, four boys competed in three events at the state meet, where they tied for 45th place.
